

HF3 – Special Session 2017 (Transportation Budget bill)

Section 125 – Corridors of Commerce Project Eligibility

The Commissioner must include that segment of marked US Highway 212 from Chaska to Montevideo as an eligible highway in the next project solicitation and selection process undertaken for the corridors of commerce program.

HF5 – Special Session 2017 (Capital Bonding bill)

Local Road Improvement Program \$115,932,000

Of this amount, \$10,500,000 is for a grant to Carver County for environmental analysis and to acquire right-of-way, predesign, design, engineer and construct an interchange at marked Trunk Highway 212 and Carver County Road 44 in the City of Chaska including a new bridge and ramps to support the development of approximately 400 acres of property in the city of Chaska's comprehensive plan.
